

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

From her very first piano lessons as a child to a four-year jazz music degree and the Portuguese musical traditions of her parents and grandparents - there was never enough creative freedom for Ana Lua Caiano.

While stuck at home during the pandemic, the young singer and songwriter began to mix Portuguese folk music with electronic beats. Harmonies and chorales, a particular type of oral storytelling crafted in the Portuguese pampas, inspire Caiano's songs and imbue them with an unmistakable sonority.







The impressive debut album «Vou ficar neste quadrado» (2024) is far from a lazy fado update - instead, it references revolutionary songs from the Portuguese army of the 70s and combines these inspirations with a cutting-edge production that spans art pop, glitch, deconstructed club and UK bass. Things come together here that many thought were impossible to reconcile - this woman proves the opposite. Live, she's quite something.

Some call it acoustic rock, whereas others savour hints of the heyday of grunge and alternative music. But everyone can agree that the Astral Bakers tap into something magical, something that was once almost thought lost. On their 2024 studio debut, "The Whole Story", the quartet from Paris combine dreamy nostalgic vocals with sepia-coloured guitar leads and an atmosphere that could have come straight out of a coming-of-age flick from the late 1990s.

The Astral Bakers have already found an idiosyncratic style that stands out amongst thousands of bands. This could also be due to the fact that all the group's members have already worked with such illustrious acts as Woodkid, Clara Luciani, and November Ultra.

In the reconciliation of apparent opposites, Boris Zeebroek finds a musical language that masters the vocabulary of Western club sounds as well as the evocation of Eastern traditions. Having grown up in the creative hub of Ghent as the son of a Chinese mother and a Belgian father, he fuses the playful agility of synthpop with the physicality of electro house and the futuristic elegance of new beat under his alias, Bolis Pupul. The result is an idiosyncratic cross-section of cross-cultural rhythms and harmonies with an unpredictable wealth of ideas. More than a dozen high-quality singles and a fantastic collaboration with Charlotte Adigéry preceded his recently released debut, "Letter To Yu" (2024).

A sound that is a true product of its time: Bracco were born out of the darkness of sweaty clubs, cleansed in the waters of experimental music, and singed in the fires of classic rock music. With their industrial sound creations, the French duo create an utterly unreal atmosphere that needs to be explored. First in 2019, on "Grave", and then in 2022, on "Dromonia", Loren and Baptiste swim upstream towards a nameless vision.



With their sizzling live shows, however, they have established a name for themselves that is making more and more waves both in France and here in Germany. A bit of Nitzer Ebb in the beat patterns, a touch of Daughters in the arrangements, and sometimes, it's as if the ghost of John Balance had stepped up to the mic again.

It takes a lot to establish yourself in the vibrant Canadian music scene by releasing numerous albums that serve as a new beacon of hope for various styles of music. But Dominique Fils-Aimé has done just that. First, she released her debut, "Nameless" (2018), which launched her trilogy on the history of African American music and was immediately celebrated by music journals across the entire North American continent. Then, she came out with the follow-up albums "Stay Tuned!" (2019) and "Three Little Words" (2021), with which she won both the prestigious Juno Awards and the Polaris Music Prize.

Understanding blues and jazz as a stylistic tradition but developing the sounds unmistakably in her own way: That's what drove the singer—songwriter with the powerful timbre to mastery.

Their middle finger stuck firmly in the face of the establishment, DVTR have not only caught the ear of an entire scene over the past year, they've also provided the perfect soundtrack for a whole attitude to life. The pair from Montreal have made a name for themselves as an unpredictable on-stage presence: whether it's mikes and drum sets being set assaulted, overpriced drinks flying through the air or vocals like rallying cries filling the room with a buzzing vibe. Demi Lune and Jean Divorce leave everything on the stage with their Francophone, female-fronted dance-punk antics. The sound oscillates somewhere between the B-52s and Jay Reatard, sometimes getting a psychedelic overlay of effects and at other times being stripped back to the essentials before hitting you smack in the mouth.

From Mexico to the UK to Hamburg, people now know: DVTR are bringing the spirit of the past into the present and still sounding as fresh as a rum and cola on ice.

Isolated from the outside world, Amélie Guillon and Elisa Artero began writing and recording their own songs in their small flat in Lyon during the lockdown four years ago. The resources were as limited as they were effective: bass and guitar, inexpensive drums, and a synthesiser. Nothing more was needed to create the immersive lo-fi atmosphere of "eat-girls" (2020). The CD quickly sold out, and when the fog lifted and cultural life could slowly resume, Maxence Mesnier joined the band as its third member.

With the summer not quite here yet, there's no need to let rainy days get you down: Later. have the perfect antidote. With their idiosyncratic sound, they recreate relaxed afternoons by the lake under the buzzing shadows of shining green trees. The quartet from Paris first came into the public eye four years ago when astronaut Thomas Pesquet played their single "Highway IO" from the International Space Station (ISS). Since then, the band have really been flying high: Their EP, "The Daydream" (2020), was a hit with the French press and highlighted the band's familiar interplay and stylistic level. Last year, their debut album, "Walking On The Line" (2023), was released, prompting more than a few media personalities to draw comparisons with Daft Punk.











This year's new single, "Cold Touch", also realises a synth-driven funk sound with more than just a French touch.

As a child, Laura Cahen learnt to play the piano and guitar, wrote her first songs at an early age, and did what she almost had to do as the offspring of a highly musical family: create. Nevertheless, it took many years before she became known to the wider public as a 27-year-old artist with her debut, "Nord" (2017), and promptly released one of the most exciting art-pop albums that France would see in the 2010s. A delicately balanced timbre, incredibly adventurous arrangements that lie somewhere between pop and nouvelle chanson, classical sounds, and jazz characterise Cahen's stylistic language, which she has presented at Deutschlandfunk Kultur as well as in the Kantine am Berghain. Diversity is written into Cahen's artistic DNA.

Her subsequent albums – "Une Fille" (2021) and "Des Filles" (2023) – also show the French singer and guitarist to be a true poet with a penchant for eclecticism.

Pulsating beats, sharply sequenced synth harmonies, and lyrics that are at once empowering and contemporary – a track by Thérèse doesn't need many ingredients to immediately catch your ear and then stay there. With her two Eps, "Rêvalité" (2021) and "metaREverse" (2023), the multi-talented French artist has already made waves in the Grande Nation and emancipated herself from the expectations of the industry.

Incorporating elements of electro as well as hyperpop and rap, neo-soul and downtempo chansons, her signature is hard to grasp and yet absolutely gripping. It should be clear that she has pursued a rather atypical career as a musician, model, stylist, and passionate speaker. However, the extent to which her various passions and talents inspire the spirit of her music may not be immediately obvious. On her debut album, "L'attente", released earlier this year, this can be heard in every single song: Free from convention, Thérèse mixes moods and genres into a sweet and sour cocktail that combines irony and wisdom, the tender and the hard, the danceable and the thoughtful, all without sounding confused.

Summer at last. Time to head out into the sun, to connect with the stars, and to let your mind wander: Emmanuel Sow – aka Yamê – provides the soundtrack for an attitude to life that we could all do with more of. The singer, rapper, and producer with French–Cameroonian roots has been causing quite a stir in the Grande Nation's music scene for a few years now – so much so that even heavyweights such as Timbaland have taken notice of him.



And that's hardly surprising given the sumptuous sound and wicked widescreen production qualities of songs such as the euphoric "Bécane" and the trap-soul ballad "Bahwai". Yamê's debut album, "Elowi" (2023), combines contemporary R'n'B with driving Afrobeats, French hip-hop with experimental soul nuances and impressive vocal variance.



Jean-Philippe Thiellay was appointed president of the Centre national de la musique on January I, 2020. He previously held the position of Deputy General Director of the Paris National Opera (2014-2019). A member of the Conseil d'Etat, where he spent part of his career after studying at Sciences-Po and ENA, Jean-Philippe Thiellay has also held various positions in ministerial cabinets and, abroad, in embassies. He was an associate professor of law at the University of Lille II and has published several legal works. In the field of music, he was a music critic for several years and is the author of three biographical essays on Rossini, Bellini and Meyerbeer, published by Actes Sud. In 2021, he published L'Opéra, s'il vous plaît. Plaidoyer pour l'art lyrique (Éd. Les Belles Lettres). He is an officer of the Order of Arts and Letters.


